

## Masterclass on Organising Sustainability Management

**Applying the UNGPs/OECD - Policy Commitment / Sustainability Due Diligence (own operations and value chains) /  
Access to Remedy – and its effect on your company’s organisation of the work.**

GLOBAL CSR **Masterclass on Organising Sustainability Management** takes you through the first steps of capacity development to implement the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs) and the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises (OECD). The international minimum standard for Responsible Business Conduct – UNGPs/OECD – forms:

- The ‘Minimum Safeguards’ in the EU Regulation on Sustainable Investments (the Taxonomy-regulation)
- The basis for the EU Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD). Implementing sustainability due diligence in alignment with the UNGPs/OECD is a pre-requisite in CSRD for applying the European Sustainability Reporting Standards (ESRS).
- The requirement of the EU Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence Directive (CSDDD)

Through the Masterclass you will become familiar with the management system that should form the basis for your sustainability work. The workshop element is based on your present organisation of your sustainability management and dive into, whether the minimum standard can assist your company organise your work from the same point of departure and efficiently.

The Masterclass consists of:

- i. Understanding the international minimum standard (UNGPs/OECD) – i.e, minimum safeguards/sustainability due diligence in CSRD and CSDDD.
- ii. Stepwise implementation of sustainability due diligence – in own operations and in business relationships.
- iii. Access to Remedy through effective grievance mechanisms – and ‘informed stakeholder engagement’.
- iv. Explore how to improve organisation of sustainability management with the same point of departure.
